This Sunday 21st May we are joining together across countries, languages and traditions, in our Churches and in our prayers to respond to the global hunger crisis. The U.N. is calling this the largest humanitarian crisis since 1945. Famines are the result of conflict, drought, poverty, global inaction and in most cases are preventable. More than 20 million face famine.

- *Famine has been declared in areas of South Sudan, with Somalia, Nigeria and Yemen on the brink of famine.*
- *Millions more in Kenya and Ethiopia are suffering from drought and food shortages.*
- *1.4 million children are severely malnourished. If left untreated, more than one third of these children will die from starvation and disease.*
