Mission Sunday Children Helping Children.

Today is Mission Sunday. Today we remember all those who have gone far away to tell people the story about Jesus, and to try to live like Jesus and to love like Jesus. They have gone because they know that we are all brothers and sisters of Jesus and part of one family with Jesus as our brother.

St. Thérèse sometimes called The Little Flower is the patroness of the Missions. She never left her Convent in Lisieux. When she died she was only 24 years of age, but Thérèse had a heart that was so full of love it included the whole wide world in her prayer. Her heart was as big as the world. We as children can do three things so that we too can be a missionary for Jesus.

1: We can try to learn about other people, other cultures and other religions, so that we can come to understand people who are different and to love and respect them as part of our worldwide family.

2: We can pray like the Little Flower with a big heart full of love for the whole wide world. Like Thérèse we do not need to do great things but small things with great love. This is called "The Little Way."

3: We can make some small sacrifice so that we can share with other children in the world and become part of "Children Helping Children"

4: We can try to be a Missionary at home with our family each day, by a smile, a helping hand and a kind word; by saying please and thanks and I am sorry, as Pope Francis asks us to do.
