This year the theme is "Human Trafficking and Modern Slavery". Human Trafficking is a growing problem and the U.N. estimates that over 40 million people worldwide are in slavery. Irish people are also trafficked at the U.K. where it is estimated that the total number of victims each year is over 13000. Criminal exploit some of the most vulnerable and desperate people.
