The weekend of 4th & 5th July, we in our parish will welcome you back to Mass after 15 weeks in the wilderness. I look forward to it very much but it will not be the same because of Covid 19 restrictions.

- 1: Remember there is no obligation on anyone to come to Mass. In fact I would encourage any of you who maybe vulnerable or anxious to leave it for a little while.
- 2: Mass for the next few weekends will take place in our Mayflower Centre at the usual times. 8p.m. on Saturday and 11.30 a.m. on Sunday.
- 3: Because of the necessity for social distancing we are forced to restrict the number to 50 people at each Mass. For the moment the Poor Clare Chapel will not be available for public Mass, because of the difficulty of 2m distancing. Both the Sisters and we ourselves regret this very much.
- 4: For the moment there will be no servers, no choir, no Sign of Peace, no Holy Water and no passing of the baskets and Communion to be received in the hands only.
- 5: If you wish to take Holy Communion to somebody living in your home, you may do so. If you wish to do this please contact Sr. Helen. 086 8611955
- 6: We ask you to use the hand sanitizers, follow the sign and direction of the steward as you enter and leave the hall/church.
- 7: **If you wish to attend Mass in the coming weeks, could we ask you to phone the parish office 071 96 41010 on Monday and Tuesday morning between 10.00 and 11.30 a.m. to get your seat number. We regret we have to do this, but we do it in order that we do not have to turn people away at the door and also that we can have a list of the people at each Mass in the unlikely event should tracing become necessary.**
- 8: An external sound system has been set up to enable you to attend Mass from the Car park if you wish to do so and you will be able to receive Holy Communion. This is difficult for all of us. We like all of society are trying to adapt our Church to the "new normal" aware of the regulations in order to keep other people and ourselves safe. We ask you to be patient with us.
