Remembrance of the Dead and Prayer for the Bereaved:

This year, the month of November, in which we traditionally remember the dead and pray for the bereaved, will be particularly poignant. We invite the whole country to unite in this moment which will be followed by parish liturgies throughout the month of November, reaching out as much as possible to those who cannot be physically present.
