Do not be afraid.

"Life will win over death,
Light will win over darkness"

This is Easter Sunday, Easter Week, Eastertide. The cruelty of violence takes only a moment to maim, to kill and to destroy. A word can cut to the bone. Clusterbombs or missiles destroy homes, lives and dreams instantaneously like the Crucifixion of Compassion on Calvary.

From our experience we know that the Resurrection of healing and recovery can take months, years and often a lifetime.

Just like after surgery it can take months of rehabilitation, chemo, physio, counselling to be the prayer of recovery.

Violence is always loud, aggressive and heartless. Easter healing on the other hand is slow, gentle and almost unseen, like the unfolding buds of Spring, the silent breath of each new dawn and the unexpected kindness of strangers. We must wait and wait, patiently for that Easter.... tide to return.

The Resurrection of Jesus is unseen. It happens in the dark. The stone is rolled away. The Risen Jesus speaks no word of revenge or recrimination, but simply a word of comfort, courage and hope. "Peace be with you" "Do not be afraid.

In a week of horrific brutality in our own country, fifty days of Ukraine's Crucifixion, endless years of Palestinian tears and more, much more, our Easter reminds us that there is hope, there is justice, there is healing, there is Resurrection.

Resurrection is never dramatic or instantaneous. It's me and it's you. It's in listening. It's in speaking. It's in forgiveness. It's above all trusting that in the end there is a reason to hope, a reason to believe, a reason to love. Every moment of every day of every year, we, you and me, can be painfully, patiently, courageously and sometimes tearfully Easter People of Hope and Resurrection. "Life will win over death".

Thank you for being such a community for me always.
